

Smart Telephone Line Fax/Modem Control

Model: STICK



The Model STICK is a three-port line sharing device. It shares a single line between your fax, phone, or fax/modem card. An amazingly simple device to install, just "stick" it into a 110V outlet, a common wall phone jack, and any phone device.

In this arrangement, not all calls will be routed through the Stick. A unique feature lets you "grab" a call and supervise the box from a separate extension phone. Almost any type of phone, phone system, answering machine, fax card and modem can be linked to the line sharer.

Programming is painless. Three easy-to-read pages of instructions guide you along the programming process. If you hit a grey area during the programming mode, you can order a readback of feature programs. All programming is done from a touchtone phone.

A versatile unit, calls can be automatically or manually transferred between voice and data equipment. Either the caller or receiver simply punches in personalized security access codes from the touchtone phone to make the transfer. These codes are ideal to prevent any unauthorized access as well.

The "Rings to Answer" feature is a great bonus. Just decide how many times the line will ring before the Stick answers. If the call goes unanswered within the designated period, the unit intercepts the call and directs it appropriately. Voice calls routing through the Stick can be answered on an extension phone.

Features of this versatile unit include:

- Screens each call for CNG fax tones, pulse and touch tones, then routes the call automatically! No switches or buttons to reset.
- Allows up to 4 phone/data devices to share a single phone line. Compatible with all phones, TDD equipment, fax machines, PC fax cards, internal/external modems (any speed) and voice mail cards.
- Hassle-free programming and diagnostics! Easy-to-read manual explains operation, features and how to program The Stick or...just call our toll-free tech support line and we will troubleshoot and program it for you! Now that's easy.
- Programmable "call override" feature affords you the ability to override The Stick and "grab" an inbound call from any phone extension (single line installation only).
- Compatible with all "caller ID" services and hardware. Programmable answering features allows "Caller ID" data to register on your display hardware before call is processed.
- Calls can be transferred silently between phones, fax and modems at anytime using programmable security access codes. Great for screening "junk" fax and computer hackers.
- "Power/Call Status" light tells you where the call is being routed. When a call is processed through The Stick, the LED repeatedly "blinks" one of three patterns signaling which device has fielded the call- one "blink" for a voice call, two for a fax or three for a modem.
- Non-volatile memory saves programming in case of power outage. No need for reprogramming or battery backups.



- Attractive and functional cabinet allows The Stick to be installed anywhere- freestanding on a desktop, mounted on a wall/baseboard or tucked away out of sight.

- Maintains regular phone service in the event of a power outage.
- "Barge-In Protection" feature prevents calls from being interrupted when an extension device is lifted. Ensures protection from interruption of fax/modem data transmissions.
